Fuhler to Moderate Visit NC 365 Panel on Festivals

Winston-Salem, N.C. (January 7, 2019) — Lynn Fuhler has been selected to serve as the moderator of a three-person panel slated to discuss festivals during the annual Visit NC 365 tourism conference scheduled from Sunday to Tuesday, March 31 to April 2 in Wilmington, NC.

“Festivals for the Rest-of-all” will explore festivals as an important economic driver in communities. The panelists - Alison Baringer English, executive director, North Carolina Azalea Festival; Lorrie Love, tourism sales and events manager, Outer Banks Visitors Bureau; and Stephanie Saintsing Naset, executive director, North Carolina Association of Festivals and Events - will address the best ways to host and maximize events and how to handle event challenges, plus discuss best practices in working with stakeholders and how to successfully promote events to target audiences.

“Destination management organizations - DMOs and CVBs - shouldn’t underestimate the importance of events as a driver of overnight stays,” said Fuhler. “Understanding how visitors conduct online searches when looking to visit a destination is key. More importantly maintaining a responsive, well-functioning, accessible website chock full of upcoming events, rich with useful information, can help in gaining an extra room night’s booking and food and beverage sales.”

“Those that play chess know the queen is the most powerful piece,” said Fuhler. “While content is king in the tourism marketing world, I believe that festivals and events are the queen. In the end, they will determine what destinations *win* the visitor game.”

Bringing together more than 500 of the state’s tourism industry leaders, the conference provides opportunities to catch up on the latest trends and issues facing the travel industry, hear insights from industry experts and network with other travel and tourism professionals.
